24-MONTH STEM OPT EXTENSION FOR STUDENTS IN F-1 STATUS APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The earliest you can submit your <u>24-Month STEM OPT Extension Request for Students in F-1 Status</u> is 90 days before your OPT end date. USCIS must receive your STEM OPT extension application before your current post-completion OPT (standard or cap-gap) expiration date. Click <u>here</u> for a comprehensive timeline of the <u>OPT STEM Application and Approval Process</u>.

- 1. Prepare the following documents:
 - a) <u>Form G-1145</u>
 - **b)** <u>Form I-765</u> Follow link to USCIS and click on "Form I-765". ISSS recommends that you complete these forms in typing and print single-sided.
 - Enter <u>eligibility code</u> (c)(3)(C) for STEM OPT.
 - Enter information about previously approved OPT(s) on page 7, items 1.a. through 3.d. Reference page 2, part 2, item 12.
 - You must sign your form with a black pen. USCIS will not accept typed electronic signatures.
 - c) Form I-983. For assistance in completing Form I-983, please see Form I-983 Instructions
 - **d) Two U.S. passport-style photos.** Submit two identical color passport-style photographs of yourself taken recently. The photos must be 2 inches by 2 inches, have a white background, be printed on thin paper with a glossy finish, and be unretouched. Write your name and I-94 number on back of both photos.
 - e) Most recent Form I-94 Go to GET MOST RECENT I-94.
 - f) Copy of passport biographical page
 - g) Copy of passport page with F-1 visa
 - h) Copy of passport page with last entry stamp (if one was given)
 - i) Copy of Previously Issued EAD(s)
 - j) Copy of STEM Degree Diploma
 - k) Official STEM degree Transcript
 - **I)** Money order or cashier's check for \$410.00 *Must be made payable to "U.S. Department of Homeland Security".* You can obtain one from your bank, any US Post Office, CVS, or Western Union.
 - **m)** Copies of all previously issued SEVIS Forms I-20 Please do not submit these to ISSS, but you will need to include them in your application to USCIS.
- 2. Submit your 24-Month STEM OPT Extension Request to ISSS by clicking on <u>www.miami.edu/stemoptapplication</u>.
- Upon receipt of a completed request form, an ISSS advisor will review your application and if eligible, issue a new Form I-20 indicating that STEM OPT was requested on page 2. You will be notified via e-mail when the Form I-20 will be e-mailed to you. You will also receive instructions on how to prepare and mail your STEM OPT application to USCIS for processing.
