Types of acceptable proof of financial support:

Student's Personal Funds

Provide a letter* from the student's bank, on bank letterhead, addressed to the University of Miami or a bank statement issued by their bank. Online printouts are not accepted.

Funds from the University of Miami

Provide a letter* from the University department sponsoring the student, on University letterhead, stating the exact dollar amount of assistance and specifying the type of assistance.

Funds from Family or Private Sponsor

- a) Provide a letter* from a bank, on bank letterhead, addressed to the University of Miami. If not indicated on bank letter, provide a letter* from family or private sponsor indicating that the funds in the account will be used to support the student.
- b) Provide a bank statement issued by the bank. Online printouts are not accepted. If not indicated on bank statement, provide a letter* from family or private sponsor indicating that the funds in the account will be used to support the student.

Government or Agency Sponsor

Provide a letter* from the government or agency sponsoring the student, on their letterhead, addressed to the University of Miami.

* The letter must be signed or stamped and guarantee the availability of sufficient funds to cover tuition and fees, and living expenses for the duration of stay or one year. Funding documents must be no more than six months old. Documents in a language other than English must be accompanied by certified English translations. Notarized translations alone will not be accepted. Translations supplement, but do not replace, original documents. Please remember to submit both.

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
